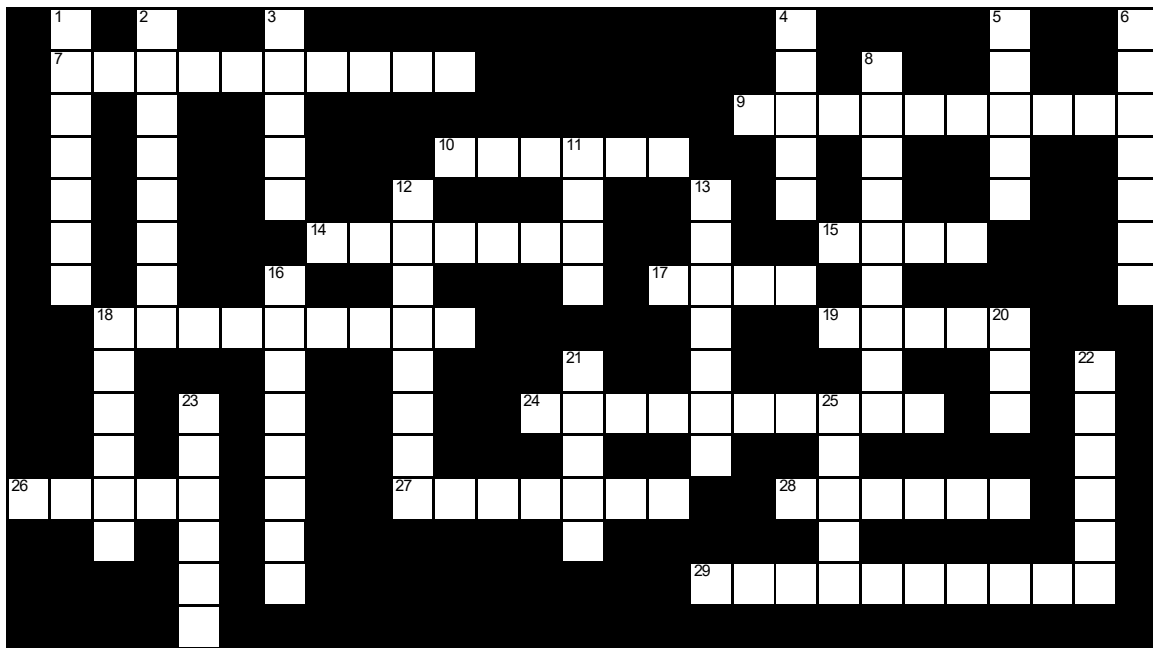


River Park Crossword Puzzle
