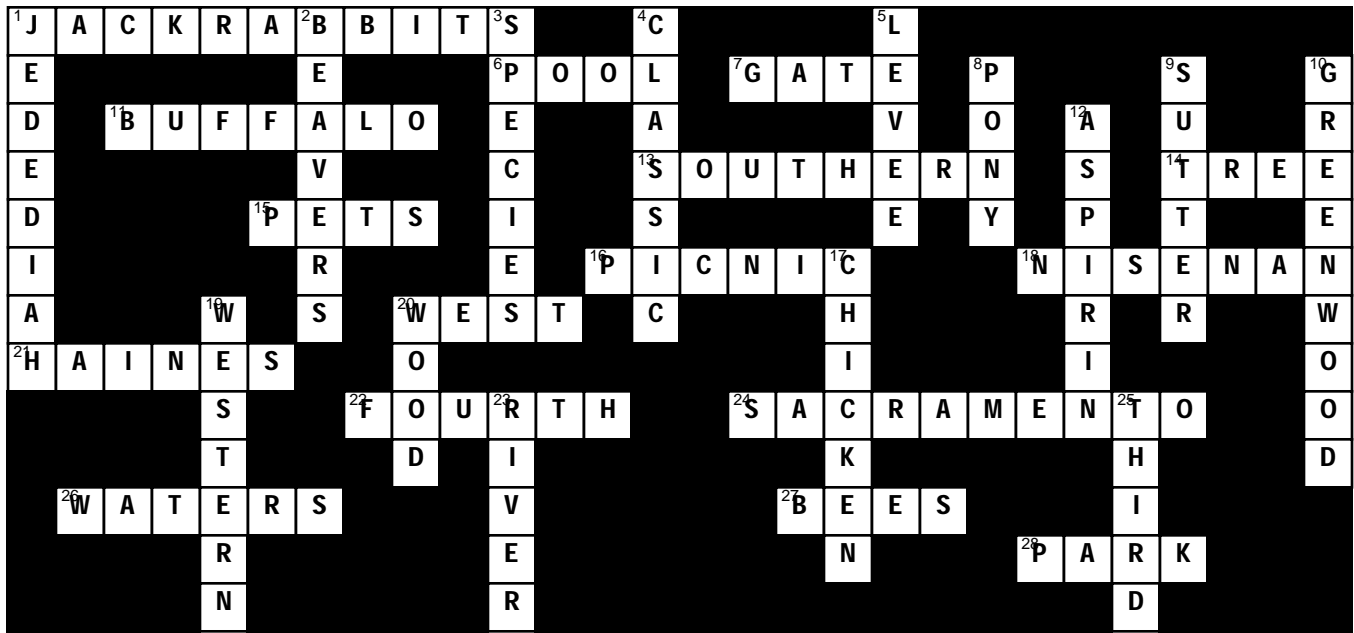


# River Park Crossword
